Historical/Biographical Sketch:

Charles Oscar Youtsey (1929-2017) was a citrus researcher who focused on citrus budwood (a portion of a stem or branch with a vegetative bud(s) used in propagation for budding or grafting). In 1956, he graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Citriculture from the University of Florida. Shortly after, he began what would become a 38-year long career with the Florida Department of Agriculture. His first role was in the Plant Regulatory Agency as part of an emergency eradication program for the Mediterranean Fruit Fly. In 1964, he joined the Citrus Budwood Registration Program as a Supervisor, and in 1978, he was named Chief of the Program. In 1977, Charles Youtsey became the Secretary/Treasurer of the Hughes Memorial Foundation, Inc. He served in this position until proprietorship of the organization transferred to the Florida Citrus Nurserymen's Association in 2007.

In October 1988, Youtsey also served as a consultant for the Mid-Yangtze Agricultural Development Project in China. The aim of this project, sponsored by The World Bank, was to "increase production, productivity and marketability of fruit in low-income areas and thus increase income and alleviate poverty." He was nominated three times to be inducted into the Florida Citrus Hall of Fame but has yet to be inducted. Charles Youtsey passed away in 2017.

Scope and Content Note:

The Youtsey Papers include the Florida Research series, Mid-Yangtze Agricultural Development Project materials, and personal mementos of Charles Youtsey. All materials in this collection were organized chronologically.

The **Florida Research** series contains papers and projects that were co-written by Charles Youtsey during his time in the Citrus Budwood Registration Program. Also included are research notes and reference materials. The **Mid-Yangtze Agricultural Development Project** series contains both the working papers written by Youtsey about the project in China as well as several pieces of correspondence and expense reports.
