Though our residential community draws students from all over the world, Mocs have a few essential traits in common — they're bright and well informed. Many have taken AP, IB, AICE, dual enrollment, and honors-level courses, and they are involved in everything from arts to athletics. They value being a part of a community, and most of all, they aspire to make the world a better place.

👍 Thirty-six percent of our **2,600** traditional undergraduates come from states beyond Florida and almost **50 countries** including Canada, Germany, Spain, Sweden, the UK, and Venezuela. **More than 25%** are domestic students of color, and more than a quarter are Pell Grant eligible.

👍 We receive 11,000+ applications for admission and accept about 59 percent. Incoming first-year students' middle 50 percent GPA range is **3.4-4.1**, **1170-1320** on the SAT, and **24-30** on the ACT.

OUR INVESTMENT

We are committed to partnering with families to make FSC affordable. Florida Southern offers **\$58+ million** in aid each year based on academic merit, talent in athletics or fine arts, leadership, community service, and need. Seventy-four percent of all student aid comes from Florida Southern and **99 percent of freshmen receive merit scholarships and grants** ensuring that the educational experiences we provide are accessible to all families.
