REQUEST FOR CONDITIONAL ADMISSION



Florida Southern College may consider applicants for conditional admission as part of the Gateway to Success program.

The Gateway to Success program is designed to provide students with a gradual transition to college academia by reducing the number of credit hours in the first term to a **maximum of 10 hours**.

Additionally, as part of the 10 credit hours, students may be asked to adhere to a prescribed course plan while enrolled in the program.

Students who earn at least a 3.0 GPA in the program will be considered for traditional, full-time status. *Students enrolled in the program are not eligible for institutional aid, and will be billed at the standard tuition rate for full time students.*

To be considered, students must have graduated from a regionally accredited high school; submit scores on either the SAT or the ACT; and submit one academic letter of recommendation. A personal interview may be required as part of the admission process.

You, your parent(s) or guardian(s), and your school guidance counselor must sign the statement below if you wish to be considered for admissions through Florida Southern College's Gateway to Success Program.
