

Bachelor of Science in Accounting

Let FSC's accounting degree mark the beginning of your success story. Our expertly designed curriculum will help you master a broad range of skills that will make you more competitive after you graduate. You'll be exposed to a variety of accounting fields, including financial, tax, cost/ managerial, auditing, information systems, and forensics. You'll also gain invaluable experience in the broader business environment while learning how it is impacted by accounting procedures. Completion of this degree prepares you to seek a CPA Licensure Certificate as a fifth-year accounting student or to apply to our Masters of Accountancy (MAcc) program.

Bachelor of Science in Business Administration

This degree will help you build a solid foundation of key business principles. In addition to practical business applications, the curriculum emphasizes civic and social responsibility. You will also have opportunities for collaborative research with one of our many accomplished faculty members. This program produces effective communicators who are competent in the practical applications of current technology, while preparing students for leadership roles in their profession and in the greater community. Completion of this degree prepares you to apply to our Master of Business Administration program or, once 93 undergraduate credit hours are earned, you can apply to FSC's 4+1 MBA program to begin graduate-level courses prior to obtaining your undergraduate degree.

Bachelor of Science in Communication

This versatile degree with a concentration in Interpersonal and Organizational Communication will help you become a leader in a variety of professions. You will not only learn how to effectively communicate across diverse populations, but you will also learn how to conduct extensive research, create case studies, and master communication theories. In addition to helping you advance your career, this program will prepare you for professional and graduate programs in a variety of fields, specifically Florida Southern's Master of Business Administration or Master of Science in Industrial and Organizational Psychology.

Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education

FSC's Elementary Education degree has all the tools you need to make an impact as an educator. Our curriculum includes the latest pedagogies and time-tested best practices, as well as full access to SMART technologies. Because education majors are required to pass all three Florida teacher certification exams, you will be immediately eligible for your teaching certificate as soon as you graduate. Completion of this degree prepares you to apply to our Master of Education program or, once 93 undergraduate credit hours are earned, you can apply to FSC's 4+1 MEd program to begin graduate-level courses prior to obtaining your undergraduate degree.

Accelerated Program

Almost any student, regardless of income, can qualify for assistance.

Steps to Apply

Step 1:

Complete our free online adult undergraduate application at flsouthern.edu/apply

Step 2:

Provide the following supporting documents either electronically or via mail:

- Official transcripts of all academic work taken previously at other colleges, universities, or professional schools
- Successful completion of any additional requirements described by program*

If fewer than 25 credit hours have been earned from a regionally accredited college or university, provide the following:

- Official transcript of high school record or GED
- Official SAT or ACT test scores

Step 3:

Once all supporting materials have been submitted, your application will be reviewed and you will be notified of an admission decision.

*Please refer to the specific degree program requirements online at flsouthern.edu/sage for other admission expectations. Interviews for Florida Southern College programs may be required for final admission decisions.
